JUNE WORKING FIRES

June 2, 2024. At 5:10am, the Blauvelt Fre department along with AMA from West Nyack (Tower Ladder) and Central Nyack (FAST) were dispatched to a reported structure fire at 658 Western Highway in Blauvelt. Upon arrival, the entire back of the house was well involved and fire was already into the attic. After a brief initial attack, a defensive operation was advised until the bulk of the fire was knocked down. Mutual aid was also received from the Orangeburg, Tappan and Sparkill Fire Departments. Orangetown Fire Inspector, OPD, RC Sheriffs Fire Investigation Unit, 44-1, 44-3, 44-6 (Dept 24 Tower chauffeur), 44-7 and 44-9 were all on the scene. No determination as to the cause has been made yet.





June 4, 2024, New City FD responded to Woodmont Day Camp for a backhoe fire on. Upon arrival, the backhoe was found in a pond on the property. The driver of the backhoe drove into the pond to extinguish the fire. The RC Haz Mat Team was called due to leaking hydraulic fluid into the pond and stream

One burn victim in the stairwell being treated by EMS, one wheelchair bound in an apartment on the floor above was pulled to safety by Haverstraw firefighter Randy Tavarez, (29 years old).

TURN BACK THE CLOCK

YOUR WEAKEST TURN OUT GEAR LINK

WHAT:...Your scba face piece is the weakest link in your personal protective equipment under fire conditions. Here is the failure process. Around 280F cracks start to form but you can still see. Recall, house fires given enough air will burn near 2000F. Bubbles start to form next, directly in front of your field of vision. Bubbles turn milky white further obscuring your vision. The polycarbonate softens, you wipe your face piece to remove soot and it tears open. Mayday? Did you survive? Was the FAST team fast enough?

SO WHAT: According to UL FSRI the following LODDs have included face piece failures as key factors.

NIOSH F2002-34, "Career Lieutenant and Fire Fighter Die in a Flashover During a Live-Fire Training Evolution - Florida"
NIOSH F2005-31, "Career officer injured during a live fire evolution at a training academy dies two days later - Pennsylvania"
NIOSH F2007-12, "Career Fire Fighter Dies in Wind Driven Residential Structure Fire - Virginia"

NIOSH F2007-29, "A Volunteer Mutual Aid Captain and Fire Fighter Die in a Remodeled Residential Structure Fire - Texas" NIOSH F2008-34, "Volunteer Fire Fighter Dies While Lost in Residential Structure Fire - Alabama."

NIOSH F2009-11, "Career Probationary Fire Fighter and Captain Die as a Result of

Rapid-Fire Progression in a Wind-Driven Residential Structure Fire - Texas"

UL-FSRI tests on face pieces proved:

1—older, damaged (aka salty) lenses failed sooner than un damaged (by heat and or scratches)
2—new, face pieces not subjected previously to heat

provided the best/longest protection

3—new face pieces, compliant with NFPA standard 1981(2013 version) are thicker and provided the best protection of any available

NOW WHAT?

Here are a few things to make yourself and your members hard to kill at a fire:

1—check your face piece for invisible damage. Shine your cell phone light thru it on to a white surface. The shadows you see are damage to the polycarbonate.

2—replace your older/used face pieces with NFPA 1981(2013 version) compliant models these are almost 2x the thickness of older lenses

3—keep facepieces in a protective bag to prevent invisible damage to the polycarbonate – Jerry Knapp

RCVFA Death Benefit Reminder


